Title: Large Scale Print

Objectives: At the completion of this assignment, student will be able to:

1. Utilize the Epson 9890 large-format printer (along side properly exposed, developed and digitized 4x5 inch sheet-film) to produce large-scale, tonally rich and neutral black & white inkjet prints.
2. Consider the role of print scale on communication and implement that consideration into their own photographic work.

Overview: Of the many benefits inherent in large-format view camera photography, among the greatest is simply detail. A 4x5-inch piece of film gives us a phenomenal amount of information allowing even the smallest corner of the frame to have the potential for significant.

For this assignment, you will each make one large-format print of a photograph that takes advantage of and benefits from large scale. Make it big, but make it big for a reason.

Materials: Among the standard materials, additionally you will need:

- Access to the Epson 9890 with 44" roll paper (provided in lab)
 - KU Beak 'Em Bucks to cover ink cost (\$.75 / per linear inch)
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Vocabulary: Scale, Roll Paper, Epson 9890

Process / Guidelines:

1. One (1) large-scale neutral inkjet print (minimum, 20x24 inches)
2. One (1) corresponding jpg file (16x20 in. @ 300 ppi, minimal compression) uploaded to the server

Both files and prints should be free of dust and blemishes.
