

## Classics 148: Rubric for Grading Short Writing Responses

<p><b>Argument: (50%; 5 pts)</b></p> <p>*The response comprehensively answers the question;</p> <p><b>Evidence: (20%; 2 pts)</b></p> <p>*The response contains relevant textual evidence;</p> <p>*The response builds a coherent argument based on the textual evidence;</p> <p>*The response properly cites the text;</p> <p><b>Style: (30%; 3 pts)</b></p> <p>*The response is 300 words (roughly one typed, double-spaced page) in length;</p> <p>*The response is coherently organized according to its argument (thesis, evidence, conclusion);</p> <p>*The response is adequately proofread for spelling and grammar.</p>	<p><b>Argument:</b></p> <p>*The response partially answers the question, or provides an incomplete discussion of the evidence;</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b></p> <p>*The response contains partial or irrelevant textual evidence;</p> <p>*The response improperly cites the text;</p> <p><b>Style:</b></p> <p>*The response is 150-300 words in length;</p> <p>*The response contains significant errors in spelling and grammar.</p>	<p><b>Argument:</b></p> <p>*The response does not answer the question;</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b></p> <p>*The response contains no textual evidence;</p> <p><b>Style:</b></p> <p>*The response is 150 words or less;</p> <p>*The response lacks organization entirely;</p> <p>*The response is unreadable due to errors in spelling and grammar.</p>
